After Kennedy's brutal death, Lyndon Johnson picked up the domestic agenda and in fact succeeded where Kennedy failed. He arrived in Congress in 1937 as a New Deal Democrat from Texas. Unlike many politicians, Johnson was mostly concerned for accomplishments rather than popularity, and to reach those accomplishments Johnson became famous for his ability to manipulate the political system.
